INTRODUCTION

In Numbers 21 we read about a bizarre incident where God sent fiery snakes to the camp of Israel as punishment for their grumbings. The Israelites wanted God to take the snakes away from them – however God had another plan. God instructed Moses to set a brass snake on a pole and said that whoever looks at it will be cured from the poisonous snake bite. When Jesus was talking to a religious leader some 1500 years later – He uses this account as an example of Himself. We too are infected – not by a snake bite – but with sin. We need to look to the death, burial and resurrection of Jesus for us to be made spiritually well.

5. Why is it important that before becoming a Christian we see that we are sinners?
6. What are some of the fears we have with telling others the Gospel?
7. How could you share the Gospel with someone? What would you say?
8. What are some things we can do to be bolder in our faith?
